






The Foundation provides annual tuition assistance funding to Corpus Christi Catholic School for families that otherwise would not have this opportunity.

The Foundation provided 2017 grant money to fund a portion of new interactive science tools for elementary students at Corpus Christi Catholic School.






Our Lady of the Lake purchased various Sacred Vessels, funded in part with 2017 grant funds from the Foundation.

The Mercy in the Parish pilgrimage made in July 2016 was funded with 2016 Foundation grant funds. A total of fourteen St. Francis and Our Lady Of The Lake parishioners walked from Corpus Christi School in Holland to Jenison, where they spent the night. The following morning, the group swelled to nearly three dozen parish pilgrims as they reached their final destination at the Door of Mercy at St. Andrew's Cathedral in downtown Grand Rapids.





The St. Francis de Sales ministry, St. Benedict Institute, hosted a conference on Restorative Justice in March 2017. The conference was organized by inmates from a correctional facility. This successful event was open to the public and attended by over 300 people. A Foundation grant funded keynote speaker fees and expenses.


