The Foundation received many God-given blessings in 2019, including the following:

- Record results in Foundation Sunday giving and highest annual contributions received in last 6 years.
- Establishment of the new Evangelium Vitae fund.
- Speaker events sponsored at Our Lady of the Lake Parish with Dr. Ray Guarendi and St. Francis de Sales Parish/St. Benedict Institute with Dr. Stephen Barr.
- Donor event hosted at Civic Center with expenses fully covered by generous sponsors.
- 58% increase in contribution revenue received from our donors.
- 19% increase in fund assets with a 16.8% return on investment portfolio.
- 28% increase in total number of gifts received.



New Named Fund

In 2019, the Foundation received a generous gift for establishment of the new **Evangelium Vitae Fund**. This fund was started to recognize the incomparable worth of the human person. Annual distributions from this fund support Corpus Christi Catholic School by providing need-based scholarship funds with an emphasis on supporting families that have multiple enrolled children. In addition, the fund seeks to financially support the school's efforts to foster inclusivity by allowing the children of God, regardless of any specific learning difficulties or barriers, to be given every opportunity to reach their full promise.



Foundation Sunday

Foundation Sunday this past year at our parishes was another amazing success! A record of over \$60,000 was raised from faithful and new donors. The Foundation is deeply grateful for the generous benefactors of our Lakeshore Catholic community.



Grant - Multicultural Books, Corpus Christi School

The Foundation was excited to fund the purchase of new multicultural books for the school library. These books give a wonderful experience for students to share the love of reading with everyone and support our diverse cultures.

Grant – Equipping Schoon Chapel, St. Francis de Sales (for St. Benedict Institute)

In 2019, the Foundation provided grant funds for the purchase of brass candlesticks for Schoon Chapel located on the Hope College campus. These items beautify this blessed worship space for our local college students and community. The funds will also be used for new presider's and lector's chairs, to be added in the near future.

"Steubenville is not just a trip but an opportunity to experience Christ and make memories that will last them an eternity."




Financial Total Assets, Lifetime Endowed
