#### **Our Board of Directors**

### Grant - Video Celebrating Catholic Education, Corpus Christi School

The Foundation was excited to fund the creation of a new video celebrating the many wonderful opportunities provided by Catholic education! ### Grant - Health Ministry Supplies, St. Francis de Sales

The Foundation provided grant funds for the purchase of twelve blood pressure monitors for the parish health ministry. These monitors are loaned out for at-home use to parishioners with high-risk medical needs. Funds were also used to obtain glucose monitoring strips for blood sugar checks; these strips would otherwise be too costly for the underinsured in our community. Health care support has long been a loving ministry of the Catholic Church and remains relevant today in these challenging times.

### Grant - Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Level 2 Training, Our Lady of the Lake Parish

A ninety-hour intensive training course, partially funded by a Foundation grant, was provided to cathecists from Our Lady of the Lake, St. Francis de Sales, and Corpus Christi School to obtain this Catechesis of the Good Shepherd training certification to serve children 6 to 9 years of age. Our Lady of the Lake coordinated the training, which develops the spirituality of both the children and the catechist through experiential and transformational learning of Scripture, prayer, liturgical concepts, and the life of the Church.




## Financial Total Assets, Lifetime Endowed

Due to the challenging circumstances caused by the pandemic, the Board voted in January 2021 to distribute additional funds to the school and parishes in order for them to address financial issues of importance to them. As our Foundation is an independent body managed by a Board of Directors whose members are local parishioners, we can respond to address needs in our own Lakeshore Catholic community in a unique way. We thank you for your generous contributions, and praise God for His blessings upon us, which have resulted in a total distribution of \$928,294 to our school and parishes from 2003 through January 2021.
