The following blessings occurred in our Lakeshore Catholic Community in 2021:

- We welcome Fr. Michael Burt to Our Lady of the Lake Parish and Fr. Noah Thelen to St. Francis de Sales Parish, and continue to be grateful for Fr. Charlie Brown and Fr. Nick Monco!
- Foundation had a 16% increase in fund assets, with a 14% return on investment portfolio
- School enrollment is 160 students, including 47 new students in the 2021-22 academic year
- Percentage of K-8 students at Corpus Christi receiving tuition assistance is 46%

Corpus Christi Catholic School

We celebrate the following distributions to Corpus Christi Catholic School, based on earnings the Foundation has received from inception through 2021:

- \$409,168 for tuition assistance
- \$321,837 for the school general fund
- \$71,726 for school grant projects
- Total \$ 802,731

St. Francis de Sales Parish

We celebrate the following distributions to St. Francis de Sales Parish, based on earnings the Foundation has received from inception through 2021:

- \$49,015 for the parish general fund
- \$76,636 for grant projects
- · Total \$ 125,651

The Foundation provided grant funds for the purchase of new presider's and lector's chairs for the recent chapel renovation undertaken by the St. Benedict Institute at Hope College. This new worship space encourages students to draw ever closer to our God through its beauty and majesty.

The renovated space is named the Saint Anne Oratory at the Carol C. Schaap Chapel, and is located in the heart of campus in the basement of Graves Hall. The Most Reverend David J. Walkowiak, Bishop of Grand Rapids, recently joined the Hope College Catholic community for a Mass of Blessing.

- \$42,711 for the parish general fund

- Total \$ 94,476






Financial Total Assets, Lifetime Endowed
