The One Community. One Faith. One Future. campaign kicked off in 2023 to build endowment funds for tuition assistance for Corpus Christi Catholic School. Our Catholic community responded very generously. New Designated Fund

We are excited to announce that a group of generous donors have come together to establish **The Teacher Appreciation Fund** in our foundation! Distributions from this fund will support payrolled Corpus Christi Catholic School teachers and staff with an annual bonus in appreciation for their dedicated service. Corpus Christi Catholic School

We celebrate the following distributions to Corpus Christi Catholic School, based on earnings the Foundation has received from inception through 2023:

- \$364,894 for tuition assistance
- \$483,030 for the school general fund
- \$77,510 for school grant projects
- Total \$925,434

Last year, the Foundation provided grant funds for the purchase of reusable writing tablets for kindergarten students at Corpus Christi. The students are excited to use them to grow in knowledge and learn to communicate God's love in print! Other grants funded for the school in 2023 included lap desks and scoot rockers, an interactive globe and microscope, and adaptive seating.



St. Francis de Sales Parish

We celebrate the following distributions to St. Francis de Sales Parish, based on earnings the Foundation has received from inception through 2023:

- \$61,787 for the parish general fund
- \$82,781 for grant projects
- Total \$144,468

In 2023, the Foundation provided grant funds toward a family area installed in the main level of St. Francis Church. The family area has new seating and provides a comfortable space for families with children to relax and continue worshiping during Mass. The project indicates to families that they are appreciated and welcome in our Catholic community. Grant funds were also provided to St. Francis for St. Benedict Institute speakers on Christian Manhood and Womanhood for students at Hope College.

Our Lady of the Lake Parish

We celebrate the following distributions to Our Lady of the Lake Parish, based on earnings the Foundation has received from inception through 2023:

- \$56,382 for the parish general fund
- \$53,692 for grant projects
- Total \$110,074

In 2023, the Foundation provided grant funds for a new Smart TV and sound bar in the social hall at Our Lady of the Lake parish. The TV system is used for faith formation, retreats, and parish events, and is making a world of difference in bringing great content to so many of our parishioners. Additionally, grant funds were provided for journals for the teen youth group, and Advent and Lenten retreats held for the parish.




Financial Total Assets, Lifetime Endowed


